OFFICERS

Section 1

ELECTIVE

The elective officers of the Association shall be a President, a Vice President from each Grand Lodge District within the State of Connecticut, a Secretary, a Treasurer and a Board of Trustees consisting Of five members, one from each Grand Lodge District within Connecticut and at large position

A candidate for Vice President or for Trustee(s) must be a Past District Deputy and member in good Standing of a Lodge in the specific Grand Lodge District that they seek to represent. Said officer must remain a member in good standing of a Lodge in the Grand Lodge District They represent during the entire term of office.

Any Elk in good standing who is a Past Exalted Ruler in a Member Lodge of the Association shall be eligible to hold Any other elected office in the Association.

Any Elk in good standing in a Member Lodge of the Association shall be eligible to hold any Appointed office in the Association..

A candidate for Trustee must be a Past Exalted Ruler and member in good standing of a Lodge in the Grand Lodge District that they seek to represent during the entire term of office.

Any Elk in good standing who is a Past Exalted Ruler in a Member Lodge of the Association shall be Eligible to hold any other elected office in the Association.

Any Elk in good standing in a Member Lodge of the Association shall be eligible to hold any Appointed office in the Association..
